- Application\*
- Current unencumbered Compact State RN license.
- Applicants should have and are willing to apply and obtain a PA RN license.
- All official transcripts from your previous nursing schools reflecting completion of the degree. Recognition of degree will only be considered from CCNE, ACEN or CNEA accredited BSN and/or MSN program.
- An undergraduate program minimum GPA of 3.0 or above required.
- Current resume or CV.
- Statement of goals and potential scholarly project essay. The candidate is to write an essay on a topic to include professional goals and a health care issue for improving patient care that could possibly serve as the inspiration for a future DNP scholarly project.
- Personal interview may be requested by School of Nursing.
